Central's Soccer Struggles Continue in 11-0 Loss at UCSD

Wildcats' Offensive Woes Extended in Program's Worst Defeat in School History

LA JOLLA, Calif. – Seven different UC San Diego players scored at least one goal, led by the four tallies of Megan Dickey, as the host Tritons handed Central Washington its worst loss in women's soccer history, 11-0, on Thursday night at the Triton Soccer Field.

The visiting Wildcats' offensive struggles continued in the blowout loss. Central Washington (1-4-0) has scored just two goals in its first five matches to date, although two of their four defeats have been by 1-0 scores against regionally-ranked opponents at home.

The Wildcats didn't have much of an answer for UC San Diego (3-0-0) on Thursday, as the Tritons scored at the fifth and eighth minutes to take a 2-0 lead. A goal at the 18th minute made it 3-0, and UCSD then twice added back-to-back goals within a one-minute stretch later in the half, including four goals in a span of 2 minutes, 43 seconds, to take a convincing 7-0 advantage at the break.

Four second-half goals, including Dickey's fourth counter of the night at the 87th minute, sealed the victory for UC San Diego.

Central Washington managed just three shot attempts, with just one – a second-half try by freshman **Chelsea Lovin** (Sumner, Wash./Auburn Riverside HS) – making it on goal. UC San Diego peppered Wildcat keeper **Meghan Michaud** (Renton, Wash./Hazen HS) with 23 shot attempts, including 17 on the goal, as Michaud made six saves.

The Wildcats continue their southern California trip with a contest against NAIA opponent Hope International on Monday (Sept. 12). Central Washington then returns home Sept. 17 to face Grand Canyon before opening Great Northwest Athletic Conference play on Sept. 20 at second-ranked Seattle University.

NOTES: The 11-goal defeat was the worst loss in school's 19-year women's soccer history. The previous record for margin of defeat was a 10-0 loss to the University of Portland in the program's second varsity game in history – Sept. 23, 1987.
